Warning (1/5)



Always use precision steel BBs for this BB Airgun. Never use any used or damaged BBs.



Always wear safety goggles when using your BB Airgun.



Do not look directly into the gun barrel.

Warning (2/5)



Never aim or shoot at people or animals. Always set the selector on "safe" position (except when you are ready to shoot a target).



Select a safe place for operating the Airgun. Avoid shooting in public places.



Do not disassemble the gun yourself. Always contact your local retailer.

Warning (3/5)

- Always point the gun in a safe direction. NEVER POINT YOUR AIRGUN AT PEOPLE OR ANIMALS EVEN IF IT IS NOT LOADED. Always assume and treat the gun as if it were loaded and ready to fire.
- Airguns are not toys. They should only be used under adult supervision. Safety is a straightforward but continuous process. THE UNSUPERVISED USE OF AIRGUNS IS NOT RECOMMENDED FOR PERSONS UNDER 16 YEARS OF AGE
- 3. Think first, fire second.
- Always use eye protection.
- Always use hearing protection.
- Always keep your fingers away from the trigger during cocking and handling. Keep your finger away from the trigger and the safety "ON" until you are ready to fire. After fire, return the safety to the "ON" position.

Warning (4/5)

9. Never use drugs or alcohol while handling this product.

- Always be certain of what is behind your target. Use extra precaution in selecting a safe target. Improper targets may cause ricochet.
- 8. Do not fire at a target which allows ricochets or deflections. Do not fire into or at water, or hard surfaces.
- 10. The Airgun and BBs should be kept in separate and secured places. Always keep the airgun out of reach of children
- 11. After use and before putting the airgun away, always make absolutely sure that there are no BBs in the chamber, the safety is "ON" and the CO, cartridge removed.
- 12. Do not load the airgun until you are ready to fire. Do not walk, run, jump or climb when carrying a loaded airgun. A loaded Airgun should never be carried inside a vehicle. Always keep the safety "ON", even when the Airgun is unloaded.



Description



Safety functions





Turn off safety device: Safety is at mid position; and the safety is at "F" (Fire) position.

Turn on safety device: Push safety back; and the safety is at "S" (Safe) position.

Insert CO₂ Cartridge



Unmount the CO₂ handle cover.



Load the CO₂ capsule into the gun.



Turn the lock system clockwise to activate the CO₂ capsule.

Load BBs (1/2)



Push the CO₂ handle cover back in place.



Use right thumb pushing safety to "Open" then use left hand to dial cylinder.



Place the bullets in the Speed-loader.

Load BBs (2/2)



Push down the Speedloader and turn right to lock the bullets.




One-by-one load the steel BBs in the bullets.



Aim loader and insert the cylinder till a "click" is heard. Then push cylinder to position.

Adjust Rear Sight



Make horizontal (right/left) adjustment*.



Make vertical (up/down) adjustment*.



Note: The best-aimed condition is that the rear sight, front sight and target are aligned in a straight line.

^{*} Tool not included. Standard screwdriver/tool can be used.


Mount tactical rail (1/2)



Counterclockwise (CCW) turn to unfasten screws*.



Use tool* to pin out spindle from left side of the gun and take out the aiming hole.



Take out both rear sight and spring.

* Tool not included. Standard screwdriver/tool can be used.

Mount tactical rail (2/2)



Put in tactical rail. Use tool* to fasten screws and fix tactical rail.



Put rear sight and spring back and insert the spindle.



Fasten the screw in clockwise (CW) direction*.

^{*} Tool not included. Standard screwdriver/tool can be used.
