

- Hopper
- B. Hopper Port
- ON/OFF Switch
- D. Battery Door



#### **Preparing Gelbee Ammo**

Before loading Gelbee ammo, follow these steps:

- Pour ammo into a container and add enough water to cover ammo completely. The minimum correct ratio is 8 ounces of water per each 1/2 teaspoon of ammo. Failing to add enough water will result in improperly expanded ammo that will not function properly and may cause jams and lower velocity.
- Let ammo soak in water for four hours.
- Drain all excess water.
- To keep your Gelbee BBs hydrated long term, add water to your ammo container as needed.

### Removing the Battery

- Make sure the Wildfire gel BB blaster is turned OFF and pointed in a SAFE DIRECTION.
- Unscrew battery door using a screwdriver (not included)
- Open the battery door on the bottom of the handle.
- Disconnect the battery from the attached connector.
- Remove the battery.
- Close the battery cover and replace screw.

#### Installing the Battery

- Make sure the gel BB blaster is turned OFF and pointed in a SAFE DIRECTION.
- Unscrew battery door using a screwdriver (not included).
- Open the battery door on the bottom of the handle.
- Pull the battery connector from the inside of the handle.
- Connect the battery to the connector.
- Slide battery and connector back into the handle.
- Close the battery cover and replace screw.

#### **Charging the Battery**

- Plug the connector on the battery into the connector on the battery charger.
- Plug the charger into a standard 110-volt outlet.

IMPORTANT: Charge the battery a MINIMUM of 4 hours and a MAXIMUM of 6 hours prior to initial use. This gel BB blaster will not operate properly without a fully charged battery.

**CAUTION:** To reduce the risk of fire and/or damage to your battery, do not overcharge the battery. Unplug the battery charger when not in use. Use only the charger supplied with your Wildfire gel BB blaster. Use caution when handling and using the battery or charger to prevent risk of electric shock.

### Operating Your Wildfire

- Make sure you are wearing eye protection.
- Fill the hopper completely with hydrated Gelbee BBs.
- While holding the hopper with the opening facing upward, screw the hopper into the hopper port.
- Switch the blaster on using the ON/OFF switch located on the back of the blaster.

### Storage

- Store the Gelbee Wildfire blaster in a safe place away from children.
- Remove the battery and store properly.

#### Maintenance Tips

- Remove all unused ammo after done using the blaster.
- Disconnect and charge the battery as needed.
- Clean out any residue in the hopper and receiver regularly.
